

## Verbatim Income Monthly Market Commentary - February 2023

Economic data remained resilient in the US, UK and Europe, although the picture has become more nuanced with manufacturing data showing some softening in orders while demand for services is still strong. Although good for economic growth, resilient demand poses issues for the consensus view that inflation will soften considerably this year. This was borne out by data for January that showed inflation persisting in some areas, particularly services, where it is linked to higher wage costs. In response to the data releases, government bonds fell in value as investors priced in the likelihood that further interest rate rises may be required in the year ahead. The changing outlook also caused equities to weaken following a rally in January that was founded on expectations that rate rises were nearing a peak. The US dollar reversed its weakening trend and this, in turn, led the gold price to reverse some of its recent strength. The fund benefited from the holding in CME Group, which saw greater-than-expected trading price increases, improved market data trajectory and a lower run-rate for licensing expenses. The position in Broadcom also had a positive impact. Broadcom posted strong numbers with good guidance showing few if any signs of recessionary concerns. Rio Tinto's share price dropped following the news that the company would be reducing its dividend. The attractive yield offered by Rio Tinto is the bedrock for many investors' theses meaning any reduction naturally does not benefit the share price. International Flavours and Fragrances also disappointed, revising the full year guidance downwards and posting poor results. This was of particular surprise given the outlook provided by management at their capital markets day towards the end of last year. In terms of activity, the managers trimmed Air Liquide after the recent European rally and given the ongoing presence of industrial risk.

## Fund Objective

The Fund will use a broadly cautious balanced investment strategy with the aim of achieving income with some potential for capital growth over the medium to longer term.

## Investment Strategy

WS Verbatim Portfolio 5 Income Fund will invest in a diversified portfolio of global equity shares and will also gain exposure to the UK Corporate Bond sector through investment in a unitised vehicle. The equity part of the portfolio will have a bias towards stocks generating a high and sustainable income with the aim of achieving a total return over the medium to longer term. As this is an income based fund, the asset allocation will vary to yield the best risk adjusted income. However, this will operate to a risk rating of 5 with a target volatility of 11.00%.



## Data Definitions

**Inception:** The date at which the fund was first managed. This can be found at the top left corner of the investment growth graph.

**Ongoing Charges to the Funds (OCF)** is made up of the Annual Management Charge and additional expenses. Additional expenses may be deducted from some funds. These may include, third party administration, trustee, registrar, auditor and regulator fees. As the additional expenses relate to the expenses incurred during the fund management process, they will regularly increase and decrease as a percentage of the fund.

**Transaction Cost** is the estimated charge for the fund that may be incurred as a result of the acquisition and disposal of investments. The charge is forward looking and used for pre sale reporting.

**12 Month Yield:** Is the sum of a fund's total trailing 12-month interest and dividend payments divided by the last month's ending share price (NAV) plus any capital gains distributed over the same period.
